Dear Congressmen Jeffries and Collins:

The Board of Directors of the Chicago Federation of Musicians, Local 10-208 has voted to supports the CASE Act designed to give a more cost effective and less burdensome way for copyright-related disputes to be arbitrated among the concerned parties.

This legislation will benefit musicians who can't always afford the costly process of resolving copyright-related disputes in federal court. Musicians face a constant struggle over the enforcement of their copyrights. H.R. 3945 would provide a cost effective tool for helping to maintain control over their creative works.
